1:10-2:40	Reading	Teacher-directed instruction teaching core reading content
2:40-3:10	M & P	Movement and Play in socially-distanced space
3:10-3:50	Reading Workshop	Individualized instruction and/or online programs
3:50-4:00	Dismissal	Staggered dismissal at end of the day
